# WORDS FROM THE PASTOR . . .

## THE MOST IMPORTANT THING

*Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.*

February holds several important days: Presidents Day, Valentine's Day, 4 Sundays (opportunities to worship), Ash Wednesday (at least for this year), and day 29 (which occurs only every four years). So what is the most important of all of those? The answer is that it is not specifically any of those events/dates. They are all important!

**Presidents Day:** We live in the greatest country in this world and we should celebrate that with great appreciation as we acknowledge our presidents.

**Ash Wednesday** (February 22): Jesus, who He is, and what He did in dying for us, is the cornerstone of our faith and relationship with God. Lent, a 40 day period, not counting Sundays, is our opportunity to focus on Jesus, an opportunity to appreciate Him more and enable our relationship to Him to be more meaningful and to have a greater appreciation for that relationship.

**Valentine's Day:** Although this day is set aside to express love in human relationships, and that is very important, spiritually speaking, however, Christian love is the most important character trait as it reflects God's and Jesus' love for us and Their love for others.

**Sundays:** It is difficult to express how important you are to the life of our church with your continued interest in, support of, and participation in, your church – all expressed in your presence in worship on Sundays. Of course, some of you are unable to be present however much you would like to be, e.g. the homebound and those in nursing homes. As important as that is, it is even more important to worship our great, loving, and wonderful God. To sing songs/hymns that honor Him, to pray together with other worshipers in sharing concerns, to celebrate Jesus together, to read scripture together, to touch base with fellow Christians, are all what makes Sunday Worship so special.

**February 29:** This is an additional day to live for Christ, loving others, doing kindnesses, performing our daily tasks. We have one more day this year to accomplish those things that God has called us to; let's be faithful in fulfilling our calling.

What is the most important thing? God is! Jesus is! The Holy Spirit is! You are!

## FLOOD RELIEF REPORT

The September, 2011 flood brought enormous destruction/devastation to our area, specifically, the East Side of Sayre, and much of Athens in the Valley, affecting many, many individuals, families, and businesses. We were able to provide some financial assistance (and other assistance as well) with grants to the several families of our church, or those connected to our church who were impacted by the flooding. The total number of persons/families we assisted was 19.

We received \$3,817.00 in special offerings for flood relief. **Thank you** to all who so generously gave to this fund. **YOU** made a difference. In addition, we received a grant of \$6,000.00 from our church's national relief fund, the Week of Compassion. This gave us a total of \$9,817 to assist flood victims. All of these funds were dispersed to persons/families of our church before Christmas.

## INSPIRATION FROM THE HEART

### *Let's Not Forget How to Love*

*"If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing. Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails. 1 Corinthians 13:3-8 (NIV)*

When Pam and I were dating, her mother made a statement that went something like this, "Some married people are kinder to their friends than they are to each other." Over the years I've thought about those words often and determined it wouldn't apply to us. Sometimes because we love each other, we tend to take the other for granted. We become more considerate of new relationships because we want to establish them. We already have a loving relationship with our lover and therefore do not show concern. I've noticed that when many couples are in the dating stage, they're courteous and helpful. I've seen the dashing young fellow carefully open doors for the light of his life. I've often seen those same couples a year after their marriage. He gets out of the car and lets her get out by herself. True lovers constantly find ways to show they appreciate each other and to affirm the relationship they have. True lovers enjoy each other. They do things together, whether it's working, participating in sports, or attending plays and concerts. They share common and uncommon interests. True lovers respect each other. They may disagree, but they allow for differences of opinion. When we really love another person, we don't presume him or her to act contrary to his or her values. We had a woman in our church that was very talented musically. She once said that people had appreciated her talent for years, but very few had appreciated her as a person. She needed affirmation as a human being and not just recognition of her abilities. Lovers care by being sensitive to each other's hopes, fears, aspiration, dreams, and plans. The Apostle John writes. Beloved, let us love one another." "Beloved" could be read as "Dear friends," as it is in some translations. He's saying, "As friends, let us love one another." Lovers respect, love, and cherish each other, not only for today but throughout their lives. *Lord God, teach us the full dimensions of love as we discover more about each other and discover more about you. May we remember to also love our enemies as ourselves. In Jesus Name, Amen.*

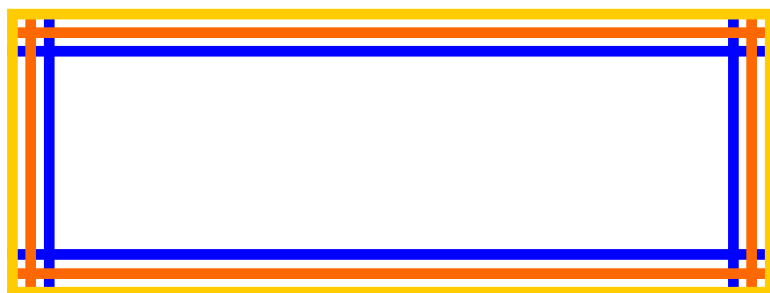
